Luis was raised in a Catholic home in Panama by parents who were separated. When he was 12, a pastor shared the gospel with him, and that day Luis accepted Christ as his personal Savior. Nedelka was also born in Panama and raised Catholic by separated parents. She grew up with her dad and six brothers. In 1991, when Nedelka was 11, her older brother shared the gospel with her and she received Christ.

Luis and Nedelka were married in 1997. For the next six years, they prayed for an opportunity to receive biblical training. In 2003 God led them to the Word of Life Institute in Argentina, where they stayed for three years, learning Scripture, training for ministry, growing in their faith, and enriching their marriage. In 2006, the Canos returned to Panama to serve with Word of Life. With evangelism and discipleship the focus of their ministry, they lead Bible clubs and camps there. In 2013 they took in two girls, Marcia and Janeth, who had been in a local orphanage and committed to becoming their foster parents. Marcia finished high school in 2016 and wants to pursue Bible training and a trade. Janeth started high school in 2015.
